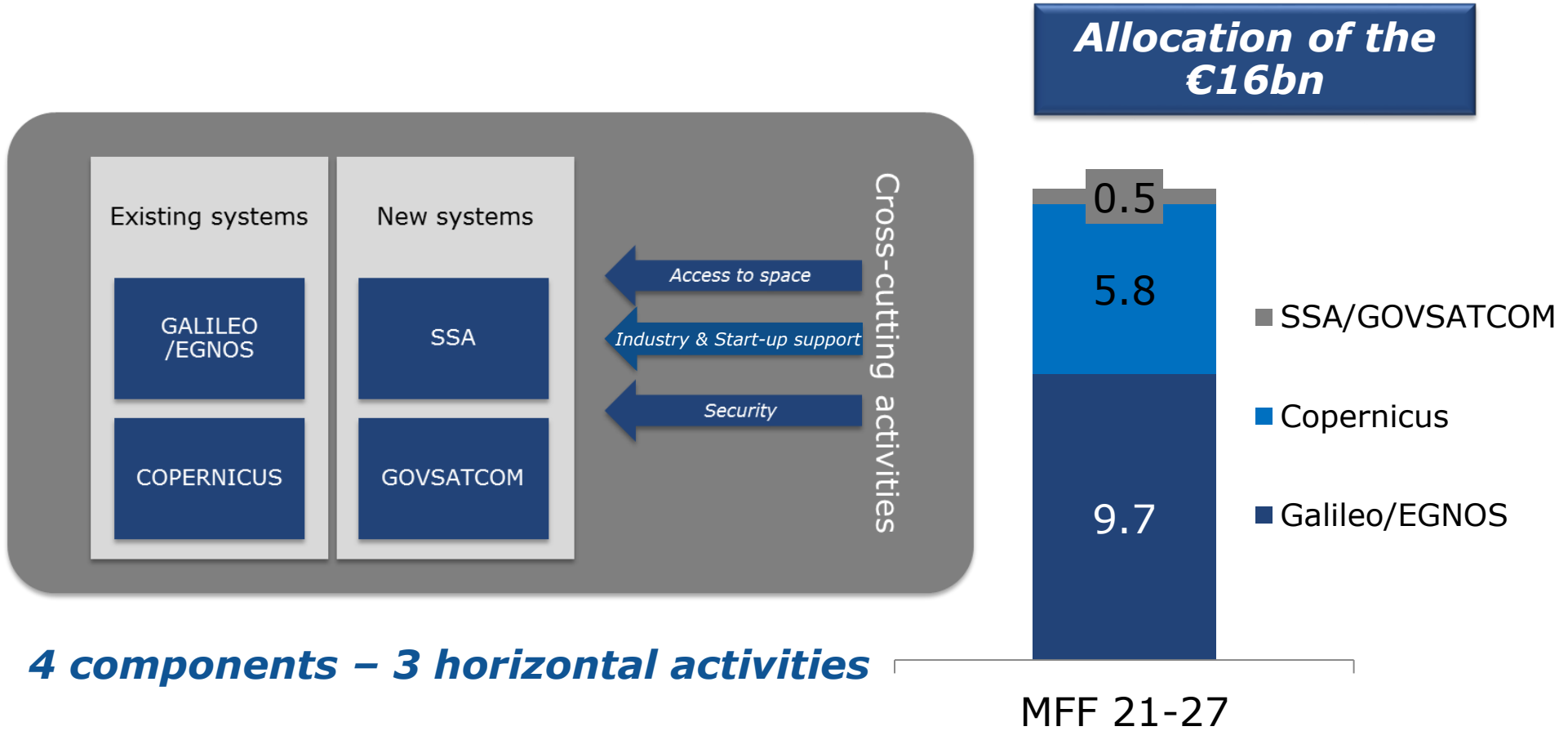

Scope of the Programme



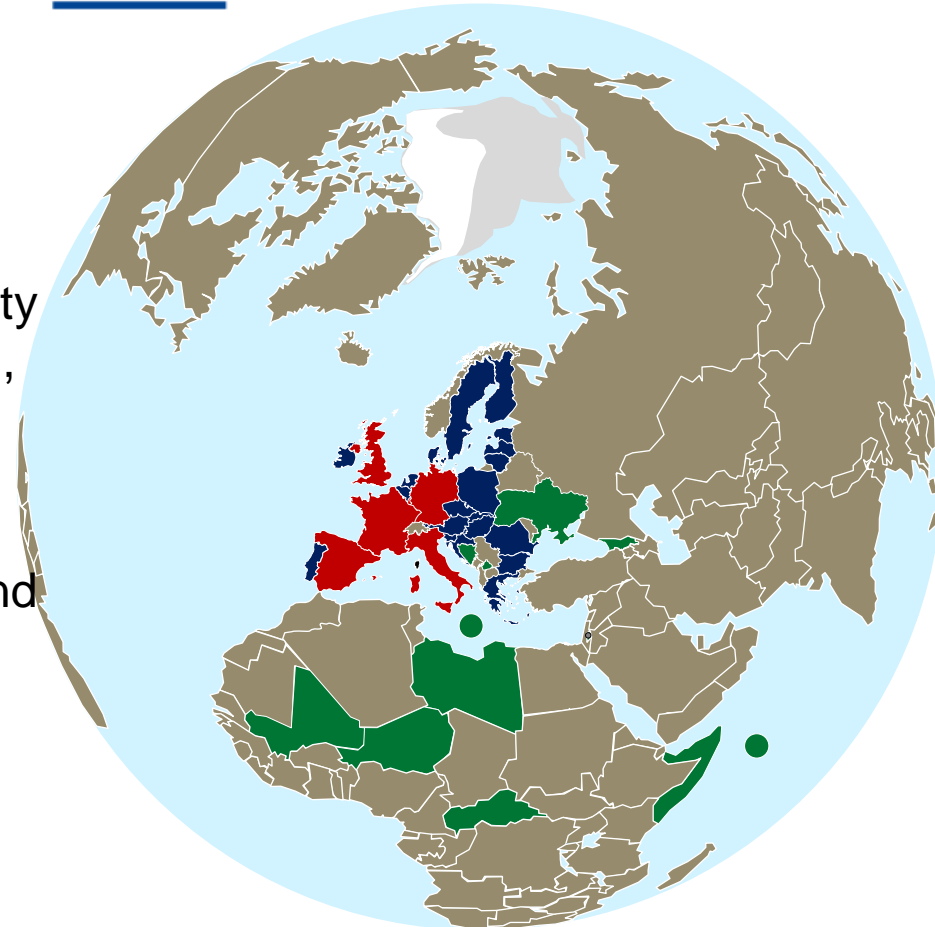
Problem in a nutshell

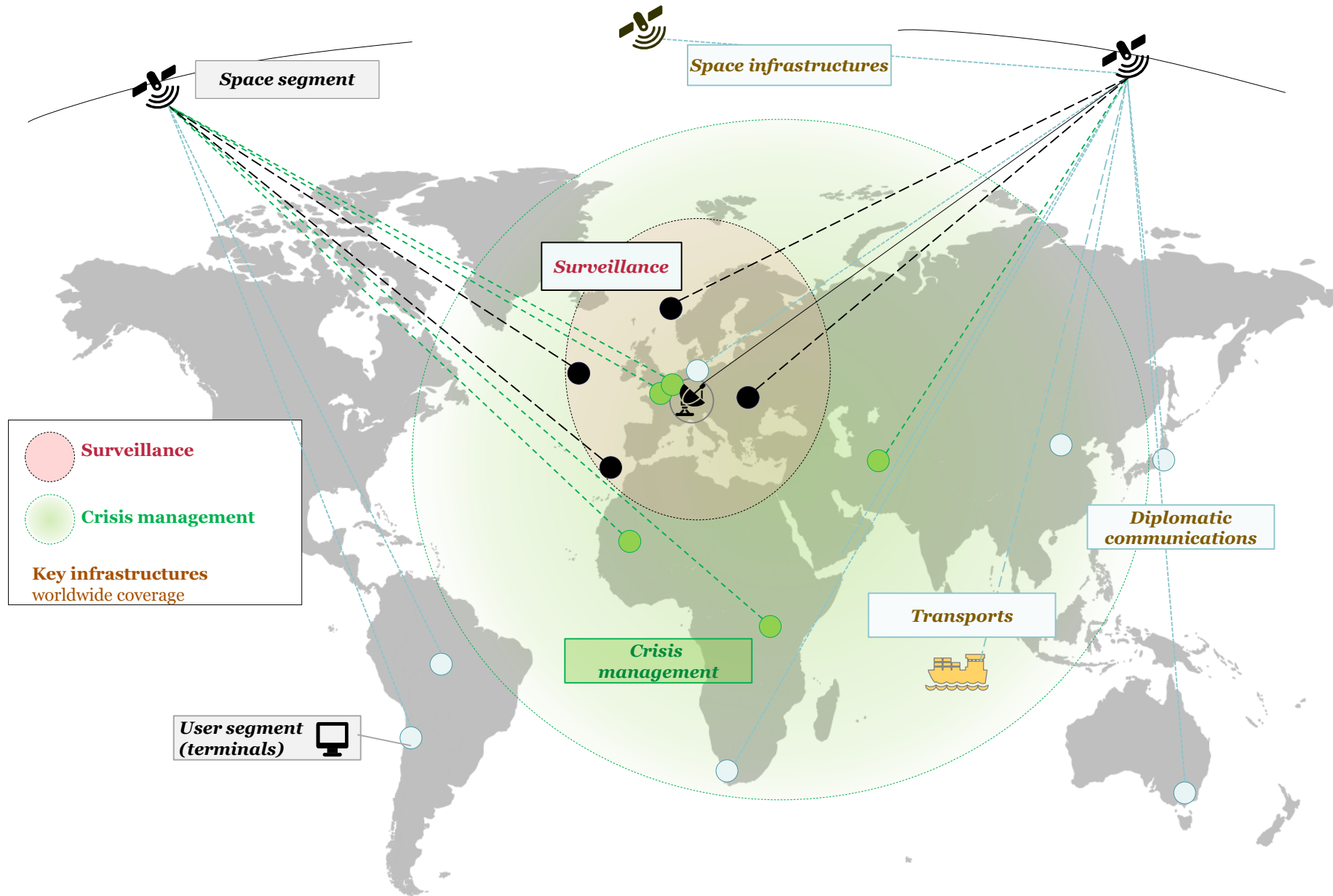

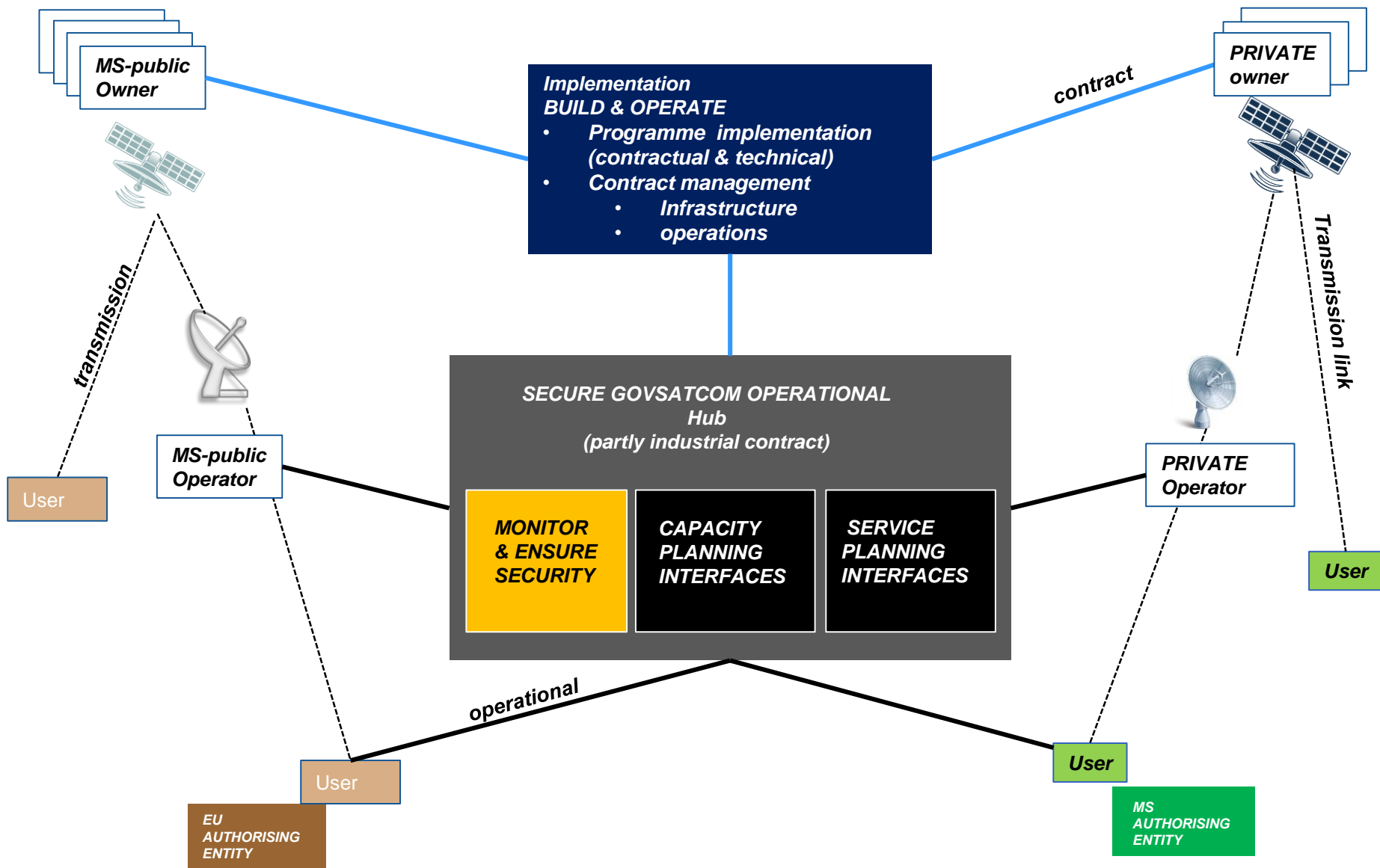
