



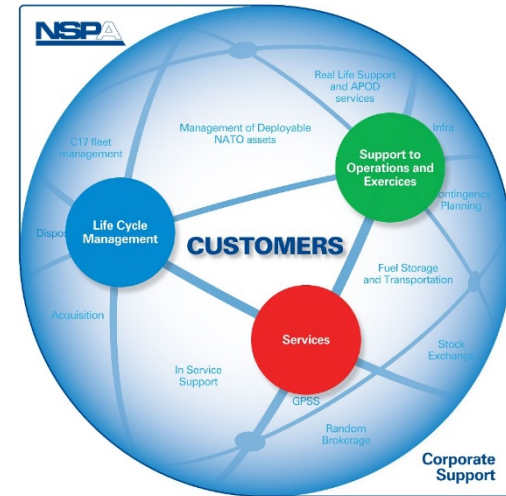

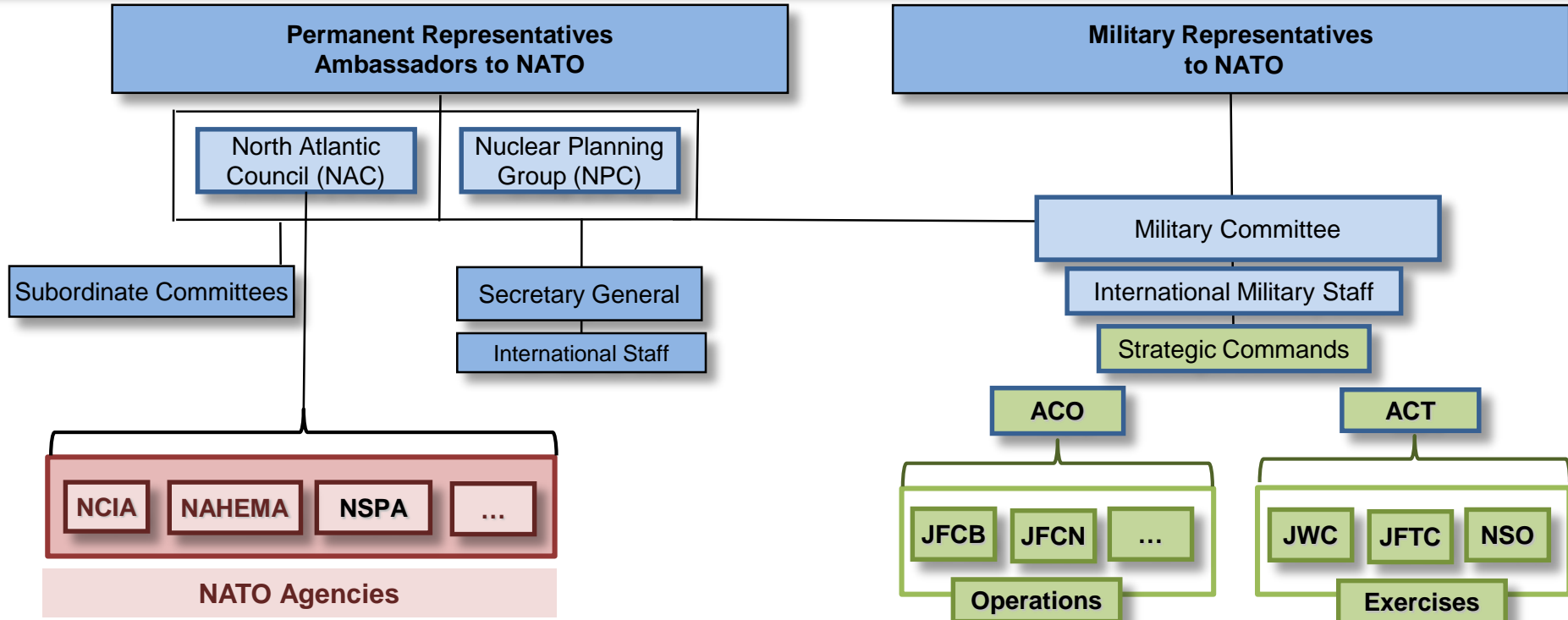

Management of a NATO pipeline system:

- largest pipeline system in NATO (9 in NPS)
- integrated, cross-border pipeline and storage system
- jet fuel (75%), diesel/gasoline/naphtha (25%)
- military/commercial business model
- non-military co-use with Military Priority Clause

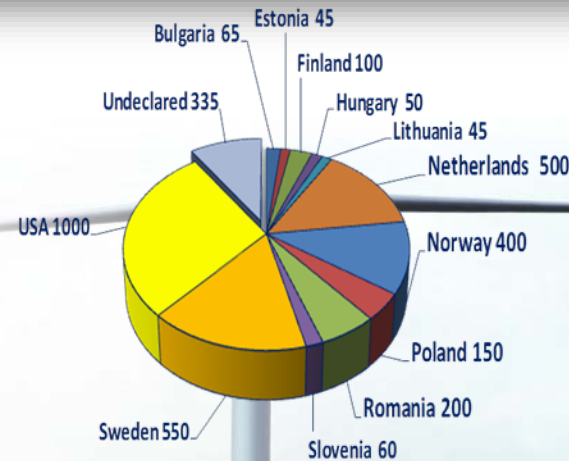


Support to Strategic Airlift Capability (SAC)

- three C-17s Boeing Globemaster aircraft
- multi-national owned capability established in 2008
- NAM directly supports Heavy Airlift Wing (HAW)

12 SAC Nations - use of hours

- for national, NATO, EU & UN missions
- pre-agreed allocation of annual flight hours
- available for 3rd party use via SAC Nation sponsorship

- Disposal

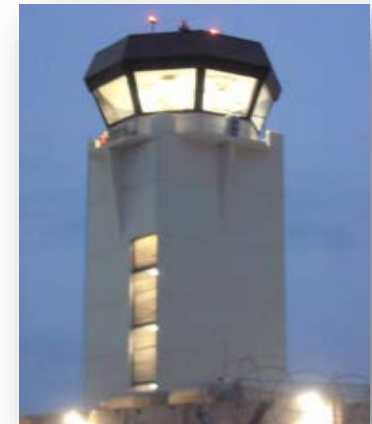
